SETTING AN EXAMPLE FOR RESPONSIBLE ACTION

We ^{all} take care!

The “We all take care” initiative encourages every single employee worldwide to contribute ideas and suggestions for improvement, thus generating a culture in which everyone feels responsible for health and safety at work, environmental protection and dealing with the company’s stakeholders and possible risks at the site.

Annual awards for outstanding projects foster identification with the initiative. Positive contributions can be emulated, thus bringing continuous improvements for the entire company. Putting the spotlight on safety issues, Freudenberg has significantly reduced its accident rate and has been maintaining it on a low level compared with the industry sector for many years.

The situation with regard to environmental protection is a similar one. Many of the company’s environmental mea-

asures go well beyond the legal requirements. More than 80% of the Freudenberg Group’s production sites around the world have already been certified to ISO 14001 and OSHAS 18011 – and all production sites have to obtain this international certification.

In January 2014, the Freudenberg Group signed the United Nations Global Compact. This is a voluntary corporate responsibility initiative to align operations to values and sustainability. The Group published its second Communication on Progress report in August 2015. The report describes how the company brings the ten Global Compact principles on human rights, labor, environmental protection and anti-corruption to life.



FREUDENBERG'S SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY INITIATIVES

Education – much like environmental protection – is a field Freudenberg is particularly active in as part of its corporate citizen approach across the globe. e², a global Freudenberg initiative, aims to build on this long-standing commitment. It supports projects which promote access to education and environmental protection through funding, company volunteering as well as expertise. e² was launched in 2015. The objectives of the initiative are aligned with the UNESCO “Education for All” goals as well as the United Nations’ “Millennium Development Goals” related to environmental protection.

Helping young people with learning difficulties

JAM (Jacareí Ampara Menores) means Jacareí Assists or Protects Young People. This private institution was founded in Jacareí (BR) in 1969 and legally acts as a NGO, receiving financial contributions from the government, private companies and other contributors. Its mission is to support and assist people with learning difficulties from a low socio and economic background whose parents struggle to make ends meet. They deal mainly with

children and young people, promoting their integration in social and working life, developing their skills and capabilities by special teaching and training.



Professional training for these young people with learning difficulties offers a variety of practical job experience, developing their skills for future integration in real jobs, attaining personal satisfaction and if possible, economic independence. JAM also offers them social assistance, medical care, sports and social activities. Additionally, JAM has initiated a special programme that places young people within various companies in the region where they are employed as office support. Furthermore, JAM organizes

extra classes for them on Saturdays. The aim is to give these young people a different outlook on life and to provide a new set of skills for future jobs.

Learn to Transform

Thirty percent of all children do not finish elementary school in Brazil. Ten percent of all young people drop out of high school. Many of them do not get the chance to change their lives because without proper education it is hard to start a good career. Freudenberg developed a free, six-month professional training course for young people from low-income families, with the aim of improving their vocational skills. Teenagers receive a basic certification during the course

on how to properly operate a machine for example. They also learn about marketing, administration and environmental protection. Furthermore, the course includes classes in etiquette, as the business environment demands polite interaction with others as an important building block for a good and beneficial collaboration. All classes are delivered by Freudenberg employees, sharing their knowledge and experience.

Since 2009 we have trained 176 students. About 24 percent of them (42 people) now work for the company while half of the remaining graduates have found work in other companies.
